COURT MANDATED PROEDURES FOR
ENTRY INTO THE COURT FACILITY

ORDER EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2020 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

GOOD CASUE APPEARING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- ALL PERSONS WHO ARE SICK, SHALL NOT COME TO THE COURT. Any
 person who is sick or who is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms will be denied entry for
 that day.
- ALL PERSONS MUST WEAR A MASK OR FACE COVERING TO ENTER THE COURT FACILITY AND AT ALL TIMES WHILE INSIDE. Any person who refuses to wear a mask or face covering will be denied entry for that day.
- ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE COURT FLOOR AND JURY OFFICE WILL HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURE TAKEN. Any person with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher, will be denied entry for that day.

ALL PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO APPEAR IN COURT IN PERSON, BUT WHO REFUSE TO WEAR A MASK OR FACE COVERING OR EXHIBIT COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, INCLDING HAVING A TEMPERATURE OF 100.4 DEGREES OR HIGHGER, SHALL BE SERVED BY THE MARIN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE WITH A JUDICIAL ORDER TO APPEAR AT THE JAIL OR ON ANOTHER DATE, IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AS DIRECTED, THE COURT WILL ISSUE WARRANT FOR YOUR ARREST.
