GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- THE COURT'S NOVEMBER 3, 2020 AND JUNE 1, 2020 GENERAL ORDERS REGARDING COURT MANDATED PROCEDURES FOR ENTRY INTO THE COURT FACILITY ARE HEREBY RESCINDED.
- ALL PERSONS WHO ENTER THE COURT FACILITY WITHOUT A FACE COVERING AFFIRMATIVELY ATTEST UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY THAT THEY ARE FULLY VACCINATED AGAINST THE COVID-19 VIRUS. Fully vaccinated means you have received, at least 14 days prior, either the second dose in a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series or a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine. The court may request documentation of vaccination status from any person who is not wearing a face covering in the court facility.
- ALL PERSONS WHO ENTER THE COURT FACILITY WHO ARE NOT VACCINATED MUST WEAR A FACE COVERING AT ALL TIMES WHILE INSIDE.

• ALL PERSONS WHO ENTER THE COURT FLOOR, JURY OFFICE, OR ROOM 113 WILL HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURE TAKEN AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL SAFETY PROTOCOLS.
