GENERAL ORDER REGARDING COURT MANDATED PROCEDURES FOR ENTRY INTO THE COURT FACILITY

ORDER EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- ALL PERSONS WHO ARE SICK SHALL NOT COME TO THE COURT. Any person who is sick or who is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms will be denied entry for that day.
- ALL PERSONS MUST WEAR A MASK OR FACE COVERING TO ENTER THE COURT FACILITY AND AT ALL TIMES WHILE INSIDE. Any person who refuses to wear a mask or face covering will be denied entry for that day.
- ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE COURT FLOOR, JURY OFFICE OR ROOM 113 WILL HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURE TAKEN. Any person with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will be denied entry for that day.
- ALL PERSONS WHILE AT THE COURTHOUSE WILL ABIDE BY SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES, SUCH AS MAINTAINING AT LEAST SIX FEET OF SOCIAL DISTANCE AND FOLLOWING SOCIAL DISTANCE SIGNS THROUGHOUT THE COURTHOUSE.

ALL PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO APPEAR IN COURT IN PERSON, BUT WHO REFUSE TO WEAR A MASK OR FACE COVERING OR EXHIBIT COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, INCLUDING HAVING A TEMPERATURE OF 100.4 DEGREES OR HIGHER, SHALL BE SERVED BY THE MARIN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE WITH A JUDICIAL ORDER TO APPEAR AT THE JAIL OR ON ANOTHER DATE.

IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR ON THIS NEW DATE, THE COURT WILL ISSUE A WARRANT FOR YOUR ARREST.
