FAMILY COURT SERVICES CHILD CUSTODY RECOMMENDING COUNSELING PROGRAM APPOINTMENT LETTER INFORMATION

When a Request for Order to establish or modify child custody and visitation/parenting time is filed, the parties are referred to Family Court Services for Child Custody Recommending Counseling (CCRC). CCRC provides an opportunity for parents to work with a custody recommending counselor, either together or separately, to create a parenting plan that suits their children's specific needs.

Family Court Services is required to send a notice of the CCRC appointment by certified mail (return receipt requested, postage prepaid) to each party's last known address. If a party is not present to sign for the appointment letter when delivered, or a party is unable to go to the Post Office to collect it, the letter is returned to the court undelivered. Under Marin County Local Rule, 7.17, a party may choose to receive the appointment letter via email or regular first class mail (or both).
