Marin County Superior Court will begin accepting electronically filed documents (eFiling) on March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Beginning April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024, eFiling will become mandatory for all parties represented by attorneys. Self-Represented Litigants are encouraged to use eFiling but are not required. eFiling is the electronic filing of legal documents, where participants select an approved Electronic Filing Service Provider (EFSP) to submit digital documents.
