A.	Strip search policy	
1.	One youth found with contraband, whole unit was searched because of it (this violated their rights)	
2.	Privacy of youth in conflict with safety of facility (items 8 and 9 of MCJH Strip Search Policy)	
a)	Rely on past and history to justify strip searching youth, does not specify probable cause for a search	
b)	When strip searched, only same-sex personnel can be present	
(1)	This is not inclusive to those who are transgender	
(2)	May be outdated	
(3)	Should be updated in writing in their policy, not just in practice	
(a)	In case of legal issues within the organization/ against youth	
(b)	Youth being aware of their rights	
(c)	Accuracy of expectations	

- c) PTSD from past sexual assaults when being strip-searched is not recognized or considered
 - d) Are there opportunities for youth to file grievances of sexual assaults or physical abuse?
 - 3. There is no language regarding cavity searches (more intrusive)
 - 4. Are there alternatives to strip searches, such as the use of technology (metal detectors, etc)
- B. Office of Youth and Community Restoration
- 1. California State Agency to guide the state transition from state-run to county-run care
 - a) Rehabilitation
 - 2. Provide youth with a continuation of care and return to being productive member of society.
