- A. The Commission discussed SB 552: require case plans for youth with juvenile hall commitments. AB 1376: Would limit juvenile probation

time to 9 months, with possible extensions. The State Budget Committee is recommending a \$15 million allocation for the Rising Scholars project

- A. The Commissioners discussed whether they have access to observe all public hearings (hearings involving 707(b) offenses), as these are open to the public per Welfare & Institutions Code Section 676

V. Strip Searches in Juvenile Detention 5:35-5:55 pm

- A. Commissioners discuss local practices regarding strip searches, given recent incidents in other counties.
- B. The Director of Juvenile Probation suggested revisiting this topic with the Director of Juvenile Hall at a future meeting where she's present, and providing the Commission with the policies for strip searching juveniles.
