NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS: REQUEST FOR ORDER – CHILD SUPPORT

RULING

Respondent Paul Brennan (“Father”) filed a request for order (RFO) on December 23, 2025, requesting Petitioner Anne Brennan (“Mother”) Mother pay him child support.

Father asserts that he agreed to below-guideline support to enable Petitioner/Mother to afford to keep the family residence as a legacy for the children, Isabelle Brennan, born 02/11/2007, and Maeve Brennan, born 02/04/2009. Father states that Mother sold the home in November 2025, and based on those changed circumstances he is requesting child support be modified to guideline.

The matter was previously set for February 10, 2026, and continued for proof of service and filing of financial documents.

Mother filed a declaration stating she did not oppose a modification to guideline support and stated she would file additional documentation, but has not done so.

The Court relies on Father’s income and expense declaration and information from previous orders about Mother’s income.

Based on the above assumptions set forth in the attached XSpouse calculations, and commencing December 23, 2025, Mother shall pay to Father monthly guideline child support in the amount of \$959.00, payable one-half on the 1st and one-half on the 15th day of each month, and continuing until further order of court, or until the minor child, dies, is emancipated, reaches age 19, or reaches age 18 and is no longer a full-time high school student, whichever occurs first.

The parties shall share, equally all reasonable uninsured medical and dental expenses incurred on behalf of the minor child. The parties are ordered to comply with the provisions of Family Code

section 4063 in seeking reimbursement for uninsured medical and dental expenses, and a copy of the NOTICE OF RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES - HEALTH CARE COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURES shall be attached to the FINDINGS AND ORDER AFTER HEARING.

As authorized by California Rules of Court, Rule 5.125 the Court shall prepare the Findings and Order After Hearing.

NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS: REQUEST FOR ORDER – MOTION TO COMPEL

RULING

On about November 26, 2025, Respondent Dzmitry Skaredau (“Husband”) served Family Law Form Interrogatories, Set One, Special Interrogatories, Set One and Requests for Production of Documents, Set One on Petitioner, Marina Narbutovich (“Wife”). Wife’s responses to the discovery were originally due December 31, 2025, however she was granted an extension of time through January 23, 2026.

On February 2, 2026, Husband filed a request for order (“RFO”) to compel responses and for sanctions. According to Husband, as of the date of that filing, Wife did not object, nor did she timely produce any documents. Wife has not filed a response to the RFO.

Husband’s RFO includes copies of the proof of service, the discovery requests, and emails between Husband’s counsel and Wife.

Local Rule 7.16 A(2) provides “Upon the filing of any Request for Order (RFO) or Motion to Compel Discovery, the RFO or Motion will be immediately referred to the Discovery Facilitator Program.”

Therefore, Husband’s motion is continued to June 16, 2026. The parties are referred to the Discovery Facilitator. Local Rules 7.16(G) and (H) govern the procedures for advising the Court on the status of the dispute prior to the next hearing.

Husband’s counsel shall prepare the formal Findings and Order after hearing.

NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS: REQUEST FOR ORDER – CHILD CUSTODY

RULING

On January 27, 2026, Petitioner Jessica Orellana (“Mother”) filed a Request for Order (“RFO”) which was served on Father on January 30, 2026. Mother requested sole custody and authority to obtain a passport for the minor child. Father has been absent. Family Court Services (“FCS”) interviewed Mother and made a recommendation, subject to objection by Father.

In her RFO, Mother states Father has refused to give his signature for their son’s passport and has not seen the child in six months. Father recently signed a stipulation for child support.

Absent information from Father, the Court grants sole legal and physical custody to Mother and specifically grants her authority under California law to obtain a passport on behalf of the minor child.

NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS: REQUEST FOR ORDER –CHILD SUPPORT

RULING

This matter comes before the Court on Petitioner/Mother’s Request for Order, filed November 13, 2025, seeking child custody and visitation orders, child support orders, and an adjudication of parentage. Father was served with the RFO November 20, 2025.

The matter was previously set for hearing on December 19, 2025, and was continued to this hearing to allow the parties time to attend Family Court Services for child custody recommending counseling and mediation.

In this parentage action, a default judgment was entered on February 3, 2026, awarding sole custody of the minor child, Norvin Aaron Tzum Mazariegos, born 02/15/2022, to Mother. The Judgment reserved jurisdiction on child support to February 10, 2026. The Court continued the matter to March 10, to get additional information to calculate support and offered the parties Mother the opportunity to update her income and expense declaration and provide additional information about Father’s income.

Based on Mother’s IED, her estimate of Father’s income, and Father’s 2024 W2s provided by Mother, commencing on November 13, 2025, Father shall pay to Mother monthly guideline child support in the amount of \$1,038, payable on the 1st of each month, and continuing until further order of the Court, or until the child in question marries, dies, is emancipated, reaches age 19, or reaches age 18 and is no longer a full-time high school student, whichever occurs first. See attached Xspouse calculation.

As authorized by CRC Rule 5.125, the Court shall prepare the formal Findings and Order After Hearing.
